

DECISIONS AND ACTIONS OF CEOS SIT TECHNICAL WORKSHOP 2020 7th-11th and 14th-18th September 2020

Decision 01	CEOS Chair will ask for agency reports to be submitted for Plenary, to be posted online (no oral reports).	
Decision 02	Presentation of the CEOS Chair 2021 Priorities to be included in the CEOS Plenary Agenda.	
Decision 03	There should be a report to CEOS Plenary on the COVID discussion at the Technical Workshop.	
Decision 04	CEOS COAST will ask Plenary for approval to be recognized/proceed as a CEOS Ad Hoc Team for 2-years. Will include a call for Agency expressions of interest/support for Phase 2 (2021) activities (including a co-Chair for the AHT).	
Decision 05	JAXA asked to join the CEOS COAST team (Ko Hamamoto and Osamu Ochiai), and AEM (Guzman) and USGS (Stryker) projects might support COAST.	
Decision 06	Two options for the way forward on SDGs should be presented to Plenary (either continue or stop), with a recommendation to adopt option 1 (renewal of the SDG AHT for another year including a Roadmap for its transition into a permanent structure starting at the end of 2021).	
Decision 07	Plenary (Principals) should be asked to consider supporting a small team to review the ARD framework and consider making it amenable to additional PFS for domains beyond land.	
Decision 08	Three WGDisasters documents will be presented to Plenary for endorsement: CEOS WGDisasters Strategy at Plenary; Recovery Observatory Demonstrator Implementation Plan; and, the GEO-LEO-SAR Flood Pilot Implementation Plan.	



Decision 09	CEOS could position COVERAGE as a cumulative contribution to Decade on Ocean Science, and CEOS Plenary should discuss ways to make this possible (e.g. via programmatic connectivity to GOOS).
Decision 10	A way forward on the CEO continuity was agreed, with some minor changes to be made to the draft Terms of Reference, and then have those Terms of Reference circulated for virtual endorsement in time to support Plenary participation by the incoming candidate.
Decision 11	WGClimate will interface to UNFCCC SEC to nominate David Crisp (NASA), Osamu Ochiai (JAXA), and Jörg Schulz (EUMETSAT) as the CEOS focal points for the ad-hoc group on systematic observations in support of the Global Stocktake process

	Rationale: Provide Agencies and Principles with a snapshot of the discussion to date as background for a Plenary discussion session on COVID and EO.	
SIT-TW-2020-03	CEOS COAST Team to seek a co-Lead for the Ad Hoc Team to be proposed at Plenary.	CEOS Plenary
	Rationale: A COAST Co-Lead will help share the workload and bring new capabilities. (ISRO has agreed in principle to Co-Lead.)

	Rationale: While not required, draft TORs may support delegation preparations for Plenary. Requirement is, "Within two months of creation, the Ad Hoc Team will prepare defined objectives and appropriate path forward for meeting those objectives to include identifying needed resources."	
SIT-TW-2020-05	When requesting its renewal, CEOS SDG-AHT should submit a Roadmap for next year, highlighting its transition plan as well as unique CEOS role in supporting GEO.	CEOS Plenary
