

## Report of the WGCapD-2 Meeting

The 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of WGCapD was held in Frascati, Italy, from March 04-06, 2013. There were **17** participants:

**Day 1** focused on status of main projects (E-learning Course, DEM Workshop and Internet web-based seminars — Webinars) and presentations by individual agencies/partners/projects. Each organization/agency focused on what they have done in terms of capacity building and data democracy that could serve as catalyst within WGCapD or work as a project in the scope of the group.

Activities presented ranged from an E-learning course to Webinars to activities concentrated on the sustainable use of space. Agencies presented a number of ongoing educational initiatives with different target audiences, including final users, universities, college educators, secondary school students and elementary school students.

The project presented by **DLR** and **ESA** (**Practical EO Education for Students and Teachers**) will be included as one of the main projects of WGCapD, since it follows the criteria defined for an activity to be considered a WGCapD contribution:

- 1. Value added coordination among multiple CEOS members (2 or more).
- 2. Should involve one or more user organizations (NGO, Gov. Agency, industry, universities, regional collaborators, target audience, etc.).
- 3. Capability to measure progress through milestones, user/professional evaluations, and other follow up activities.
- 4. Meet at least one of the 4 objectives of data democracy with preference of meeting multiple objectives.

Based on the need to develop an overarching strategy, an issue highlighted at the WGCapD-1 meeting in 2012, Jacob Sutherlun presented a new project proposal: **Inventory of capacity building activities**.

### The rationale includes:

- 1- Capacity building activities are being carried out across the globe by various organizations
- 2- Lack of coordination leads to less than efficient use of limited resources
- 3- Many organizations are simply not aware of many of the capacity building activities focusing on the use of space-derived data

The primary objective of this project is to compile all current capacity-building efforts on the use of space-derived Earth observation (EO) data for societal benefits into an easily updateable format. Once completed, the project will serve as a comprehensive resource of ongoing capacity-building efforts, helping those actors involved better coordinate their existing activities and possibly inform future planning.

There was a long discussion about this proposal and suggestions included format of questionnaire, how to update it, how to get funds to implement the project, connections with GEONetCab project, among others.



Eric Wood presented a new USGS/ UNEP Project Proposal - Africa's Historical Aerial Photography - Preserving 75 Years of Earth Observations aiming to seek possible synergies with our group.

During **Day 2** we continued with presentations by agencies along with some very interesting educational and training resources available:

- 1- USGS: LSI portal, ASMET (African Satellite Meteorology Education & Training)
- 2- Examples of Datasets "Supported" by USGS: National Land Cover DB, National topography (DEM, LiDAR), NIDIS, VegDRI (drought), Phenology, Global Multi-resolution Terrain Elevation Data, GeoSur Development of a Geospatial Information Network for South America (DEM derivatives), International Charter, Landsat Browse products, Afghanistan Portal, FEWS-NET (famine early warning), LPDAAC (MODIS, ASTER with NASA), Global mangrove database, West Africa Landcover.
- 3- ESA's ibook (http://www.esa.int/Highlights/ESA s first iBook)
- 4- METeD learning modules: UCAR (University Corporation for Atmospheric Research) https://www.meted.ucar.edu/ and COMET Program (http://comet.ucar.edu/).
- 5- ESA Tiger Project and other resources

Regarding the internal coordination of WGCapD with other WG's, Ivan Petiteville, presented, on behalf of **CEOS** ad hoc Disaster Team, possible support our group could give to DRM(Disaster Risk Management) Capacity Building Activities. Growing political interest in DRM might be an opportunity for space agencies to play a major role in near future. Recent major international conferences, publications and declarations from decision-makers explicitly refer to the necessity to increase the means of observations including from satellites. A WGCapD person was invited to join the CEOS DRM team and to participate to all activities, making the liaison with the WG itself.

During the Discussion Session, some questions were raised, leading to a very fruitful debate:

- ➤ How can the WG support the CB activities within CEOS? Looking at VC's and WG's

  One idea was to have VC's and WG's have an E-Learning point of contact for us. We could
  work with that person to develop and/or coordinate E-Learning courses for those specific
  areas. The inventory would also serve as a coordination tool for VC's to see what the other
  ones were doing. A subset of the inventory might be useful for in-CEOS coordination
- ➤ How do we help users find the training resources that are available from individual resources?

WGCapD website includes a link called "Resources" which shall be populated with various kinds of links to teaching material, GEONetCab Portal, databases etc.

➤ How can we improve the visibility of CEOS and particularly WGCapD within our own organizations?

Our group should have a top-level role, stimulating, coordinating and creating opportunities! Data Democracy is the focus!
