Notes from WGISS-36 CEOS Water Portal project Session

- 1. Satoko Miura (JAXA) gave a brief introduction of the session's agenda.
- 2. Shinich Sekioka (JAXA) gave a presentation with an emphasis on status update since the last WGISS meeting. The updates include a OpenSearch access to NASA ECHO and recent coordination with NOAA National Climatic Data Center (NCDC) for future collaboration.
- 3. Yoshiyuki Kudo (JAXA/RESTEC) explained the ongoing development regarding new architecture of the water portal and participation in AIP-6 GEOSS Water Services.
- 4. Following questions were asked and answered.
 - (1) In the context of GI-Cat (Open source software) that is used in the new architecture development effort:
 - Did you customize it to fit your use?
 - > No. We are using it as is. (Yoshi)
 - Is it capable of harvesting OpenSearch service resources as well?
 - > Yes. (Yoshi)
 - How is the performance of the software?
 - > We're planning to test and evaluate the performance to see if it can handle large number of datasets. (Yoshi)
 - (2) In the context of GEO DAB OpenSearch, is it OGC compliant?
 - Yes, it is OGC OpenSearch compliant. (Yoshi)
