- SIT TW Draft v0.1 Agenda circulated for CEOS SEC review on July 10.
- The agenda is driven by the objectives of CEOS Plenary and the sessions will be focused on coordination and preparation for the related items at Plenary.
- Welcome feedback before (via email to sit-chair@lists.ceos.org) or at CEOS SEC-267, during which we will provide a brief overview and an opportunity for any comments.
- The plan is, from a logistics point of view, for the opening and closing sessions to be similar to SIT (formal), but looking for the rest of the sessions to be more relaxed.

VC Reports to CEOS SEC Meetings

- The opportunity to report to SEC meetings was well received by the VC Leads, based on the feedback the SIT Chair received during our consultation calls.
- As such, the SIT Chair proposes a second round of reports from the VCs starting at SEC-268.

Other highlights, activities, actions, projects, collaborations

GEO Executive Committee Meeting

- The SIT Co-Chairs attended the 52nd meeting of the GEO Executive Committee on 7 and 8 July. The meeting was held virtually.
- Key highlights:
 - o The GEO Knowledge Hub Implementation Plan was approved after a long period of debate and concern, particularly about its resourcing implications and possible duplication of current/planned activities. Implementation will be an incremental step-wise approach with review after 12 months. The GKH will become a component of the GEOSS Platform (GEOSS Common Infrastructure) alongside those modules that facilitate access to CEOS Agency datasets. The success of the GKF Model depends on Analysis Ready Data being made available as well managed collections in public / commercial cloud platforms.
 - The Executive Committee will invite CEOS to provide an update on the CEOS ARD Strategy, including progress on the generation of 'analysis ready data' products by CEOS Agencies. This is a result of the references in the Canberra Ministerial Declaration calling on space agencies to strengthen their work in this area.
 - o The Executive Committee agreed to postpone the next face-to-face Plenary meeting to 2021, to be held in South Africa. An 'extraordinary executive committee' meeting will be held in October/November to ensure critical GEO business is concluded. This meeting (or preparatory meetings) will be open to all Members and POs to ensure their voice is heard on major items of business like the GEO Work Programme. As

there will not be a Plenary, it is not clear that there will be a forum or opportunity for presentation of a "CEOS Statement".

Carbon & Biomass

- SIT TW session will feature a number of invitees, including from UNFCCC SEC, GCOS, GFOI and IPCC. Significant discussion time is planned on optimising the space agency participation in the processes of setting requirements and supporting the Global Stock Take.
- The AFOLU Roadmap team has started to draft its report under leadership of Osamu Ochiai and Frank Martin Seifert.
- We have been advised that the CEOS Biomass Protocol is still on track for release soon. And that work on the business case for support from CEOS Principals will commence in time for presentation at Plenary.

<u>SDGs</u>

- SIT Chair team drafted SDG session with SDG AHT co-leads for SIT TW: objectives are to showcase some applications + option for the SDG AHT future on the table for the Plenary
- Updates on SDG algorithms (Brian's report) DEA applications to be discussed with Adam
- Subteams working on the Requirements tables + narrative around it
- Updated SDG inputs submitted to Kerry for the CEOS WP
- Next call with AHT members 22nd July: progress on Requirements + SIT TW agenda to be reviewed

<u>ARD</u>

- The WGCV Peer Review process of the CARD4L self-assessments submitted by the USGS for their Landsat Collection 2 Surface Reflectance and Surface Temperature products was completed and endorsed as CARD4L compliant at the Threshold level;
- The first Science Expert Review Panel teleconference to discuss and review the Aquatic Reflectance CARD4L PFS (AR PFS) draft was successfully held on July 25. Outcomes from the telecon as well as written feedback provided by July 10 will be used to update the document;
- CEOS-Industry ARD webinar was successfully held on July 1. There were 490 registrations, 227 connected to the live discussion and more than 580 views of the webinar (live and recorded views). Please find the full recorded workshop at the CEOS ARD webpage (ceos.org/ard);
