SIT-37

- SIT-37 final minutes were circulated on June 3. Thanks to all who commented.

Carbon & Biomass

- As agreed during SIT-37 (action SIT-37-10), SIT Chair Team met with IMEO on 2nd June to progress a scoping paper defining the nature of the cooperation with CEOS. Volunteers from GHG Task Team, WGCV, and AC-VC will help review and refine the paper before it is shared with the relevant CEOS agencies responsible for the missions in any intercomparison experiment. A draft will be shared with SEC for the next telcon.
- The AFOLU Roadmap team plans to meet in ESA ESRIN (Frascati, Italy) on 12 Sep just ahead of SIT TW.

CEOS-ARD

- LSI-VC-11 meeting presentations are on the <u>CEOS website</u>. Discussions included CEOS-ARD for Land updates and on strategies to increase the utility and impact of LSI-VC and CEOS-ARD.
- Convening a call on the 16th of June to explore the specifics of CEOS-ARD for hyperspectral sensors.
- CEOS-ARD Oversight Group will meet again on the 22nd of June to progress the updated PFS template, which will be more generalised for all thematic domains.
- CEOS-ARD Newsletter #2 will be released soon. It will be a special edition focused on CEOS-ARD @ Living Planet Symposium. Sign up for the newsletter

SDG Coordination

- The group will meet Tuesday 14 June.

The two documents discussed at SIT-37 (What CEOS can do to support the U.N. 2030 Agenda and the SDGs; and, CEOS expectations for the GEO Secretariat regarding support of the SDGs) have been posted at ceos.org/sdg.

Upcoming meetings or events

- SIT TW: we hope will allow the first in-person CEOS meeting in more than 2.5 years. Currently we are planning for that outcome (Tue 13 Thu 15 Sept). A room is reserved for an "AFOLU Roadmap Team GCOS TOPC" meeting on Mon 12 Sept, and a "CEOS ARD and Standards" on 13 Sep. A week at a glance and logistics information is in preparation. A survey has been sent to all CEOS lists to seek to establish how many colleagues plan to attend in person to allow us to plan logistics. - We hope to include a 'New Space & Future CEOS' session in the TW agenda noting the significant interest generated by our teaser session at SIT-37. We will aim to poll the CEOS community on the topics and approach. We recognise the rapid and significant changes in the sector are of high interest to CEOS agencies, and we propose to focus on

measures to ensure impact from our public EO programmes and to ensure societal impact overall for the sector and benefits for the user. We may explore the idea of pitches at TW on measures to support these objectives, such as:

- Identify the strengths of both the public and private sectors that could be used at best in a coordinated manner to improve the services to the user community at large, and to support international agreements and policies.
- Use of legacy cal-val infrastructure to serve the New Space sector and support improved accuracy of smallsats.
- SITSATs and calibration transfer
- Key data standards for data mixing (ARD, etc.)
- SIT-38 is proposed to be held at ESA ESRIN (Frascati, Italy) in the week of 27th March 2023. Tue 28th March will be assigned to side meetings and Wed 29th and Thu 30th March will be the main days for SIT-38. Meeting room bookings at ESRIN are still being confirmed. SEC agencies are invited to raise any known conflicts in the meantime.
- A June call of the CEOS Oceans coordination group is being planned. A survey of CEOS Contributions to Oceans Activities is currently open for agency contributions.
