The SEO is planning to participate in a WGISS "Jupyter Notebook Day" in September. In addition, the SEO is working with GEO to develop a set of webinars for the GEO Knowledge Hub. These events will highlight some of the Open Data Cube Sandbox applications and inspire more people to use CEOS satellite data in the cloud via Jupyter notebooks (Python scripts).

- The SEO is supporting the 2023 Better Working World Data Challenge through a collaboration with GEO and Ernst & Young (EY). Past support was also provided by CSIRO and GA. This competition is focused on students and young professionals and uses satellite data and machine learning to address a specific issue. The proposed topic for 2023 is rice crop monitoring and SDG 2 (Food Security). The SEO has been in contact with GEO, NASA Harvest, Radiant Earth, VNSC, and Asia-Rice to attempt obtain ground validation data (rice crop locations and yield data).
- The SEO met with GEO (Aug 25) to review recent CEOS communications activites, learn about GEO's latest communications strategy, and identify future opportunities to support each other's activities through joint campaigns and other means. Laurent Durieux and GEO's new Strategic Communications Specialist, Sam Nuttall, attended. Shared communications priorities were identified and quarterly CEOS/GEO communications meetings were agreed upon.
