Introduction



GEO 2009-2011 WP – Tasks Proposed by CEOS

- Call from the GEO Secretariat to propose new tasks for the new GEO 2009-2011 WP (March 08)
- CEOS' response (May 2008):
 - Five new tasks
 - Refocus the scope of two existing GEO 2007-2009 tasks.
- CEOS ready to lead / co-lead these new tasks, in addition to the several GEO 2007-2009 WP tasks supported by CEOS in 2008 (POC, Lead, Contributor)



Detailed Tasks Proposals

5 new GEO tasks:

- "Development of an Africa Water Observation System." (Water, TIGER, ESA)
- "Implementation of a GEO data quality assurance strategy" (WGCV, ESA)
- "End-to-end GEOSS Space Segment Architecture" (CSA)
- "Implementation of a Malaria Warning System" (Health, NOAA)
- "Forest Monitoring for Carbon Tracking" (NSC, CSIRO, JAXA)

2 existing GEO tasks to be modified;

- "Management of Energy Sources" (Energy, NASA)
- "Virtual Constellations" (pending approval of 2 new constellations)



GEO 2009-2011 WP Schedule

- Version V1 Issued on Jul. 1
 - Comments on V1 to be provided by GEO Members & Participating Organizations before Aug. 8
- Version V2 issued on Sep. 1
 - Comments on V2 to be sent before Oct. 3
- Version V3 to be issued in Oct. for acceptance at GEO-V Plenary

GEO 2009-2011 WP v1 – CEOS Review

- CEOS has proposed 7 tasks (5 new ones and 2 existing to be modified) and 6 have been retained
 - The objectives of the "End-to-end GEOSS Space Segment Architecture" are somehow addressed through other GEO tasks
- CEOS review summary:
 - Detailed comments from the CEOS Members on various tasks
 - In v1, CEOS requested to lead / co-lead 11 GEO tasks/sub-tasks.
 In addition, CEOS requests to be added to the list of Co-leads for 3 GEO tasks/sub-tasks.
 - CEOS may contribute to 48 tasks / sub-tasks

GEO 2009-2011 WP v2 – CEOS Preliminary assessment

- Most of the CEOS comments have been taken into account.
 - A couple of issues are being discussed with the GEO Secretariat
- Almost all requests from CEOS to Lead / Colead 12 specific GEO tasks / sub-tasks have been taken into account (see list in next three slides)

 - sub-task led by USA and CEOS
- 4. AR-09-02: Connecting Observation Systems for GEOSS
 - a) Virtual Constellations (former DA-07-03)
 - sub-task led by CEOS and GTOS



GEO Tasks Led / Co-led by CEOS (2/3)

- **5.** AR-09-03: Advocating for Sustained Observing Systems
 - a) Key Climate Data from Satellite Systems (former CL-06-02)
 - sub-task led by USA, CEOS, GCOS and WMO
- 6. DA-09-03: Global Data Sets
 - e) Global DEM (former DA-07-01)
 - sub-task led by Japan and CEOS
- 7. DA-09-05: Global Carbon Observation and Analysis System
 - b) Forest Carbon Tracking
 - sub-task led by Australia, Japan, Norway, CEOS, FAO and GTOS
- **8. DI-06-09:** Use of Satellites for Risk Management
 - task led by Canada, China, CEOS and UNOOSA



GEO Tasks Led / Co-led by CEOS (3/3)

- 9. HE-09-03: End to End Projects for Health
 - b) Implementation of a Malaria Early Warning System
 - sub-task led by CEOS
- **10.EN-07-01:** Management of Energy Sources
 - task led by Germany, CEOS and IEEE
- 11.WA-06-07: Capacity Building for Water Resource Management
 - b) Africa
 - sub-task led by CEOS and USA
- 12.CL-06-01: Sustained Reprocessing and Reanalysis of Climate Data
 - task is led by CEOS and GCOS

Conclusions

- GEO 2009-2011 WP v2 is globally satisfactory for CEOS' point of view
 - A couple of issues are being discussed with GEO Secretariat
- CEOS responsibility has increased wrt previous 2006-2009 WP as both Lead/Co-Lead/POC and Contributor (from 5 to 12 as Lead)
- CEOS must allocate the adequate resources, to produce expected results in a timely manner.
 - Incl. regular reporting to GEO SEC / GEO Task Teams
