

- Transition to permanent address (**www.ceos.org**) was completed by the SEO in January 2009.
- Website utilizes a Content Management System (CMS) approach called Joomla.
- Joomla requires less overall administrative burden and allows users to maintain content easily.
- Improved access to CEOS content, direct links to the CEOS calendar, Actions, GEO, EO Handbook data.
- This new approach to website management should improve CEOS communications and keep the content current.

Future Plans

- Merge content from existing Working Groups into new Joomla format. Test sites already completed for WGCV and WGEdu.
