SIT-23 Meeting Objectives

- Secure CEOS Principals' and CEOS entities' commitments to leading/making key contributions to GEO Tasks/Sub-Tasks
- Progress key CEOS deliverables (including Forest Carbon and Greenhouse Gases) for GEOSS, G8, and Climate Conventions
- Assess progress of CEOS Virtual Constellations with respect to SIT and GEO-related activities
- Decide if CEOS wishes to develop one or two "Threads" in demonstrating the value chain in analysis of one or two key GEOSS observational gaps





2nd CEOS Actions in Support of GEO Remapping Workshop January 27-28, 2009 – Silver Spring, MD

- Addressed candidate Thread topics for observational gaps analysis for key GEOSS data gaps
 - Climate, Carbon, Water, and Cryosphere/Sea Level Rise
- Defined new CEOS actions in support of the GEO 2009-2011 Work Plan
 - Focused on Tasks and Sub-Tasks that CEOS leads or co-leads or makes a significant contribution to
 - 85 actions addressing 36 GEO Tasks/Sub-Tasks were identified
 - 63 of those 85 have been characterized as Category 1 or 2
