Side events and side meetings

- UNFCCC and SBSTA expect presentations from CEOS, mainly in SBSTA side meetings
- Better coordination amongst organizations working on climate issues to avoid unnecessary competition
- CEOS agencies to provide ground support in Mexico
- Review of the CEOS statement to COP-15
- Preparation of a shorter statement to be used in case an opportunity to speak arises

- Ground support in Mexico
 - Need to identify people to staff the booth
- Rethink printed material: less words and more pictures
- Posters seem to be more effective than brochures
- Distribution of electronic version of the CEOS EO Handbook





Actions

- Current CEOS Chair (INPE), Incoming CEOS Chair (CDTI) and SIT Chair (JAXA) to remain at the head of coordination for CEOS activities at COP-16
