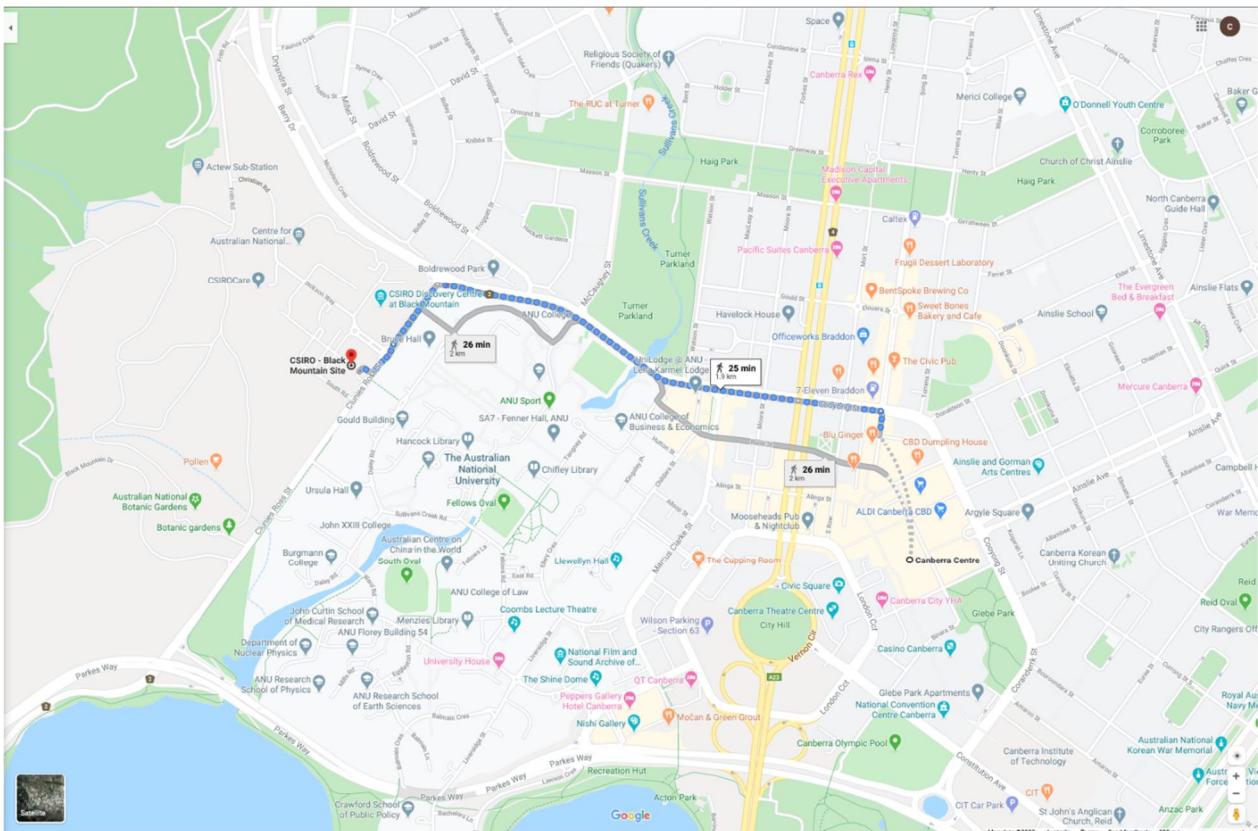

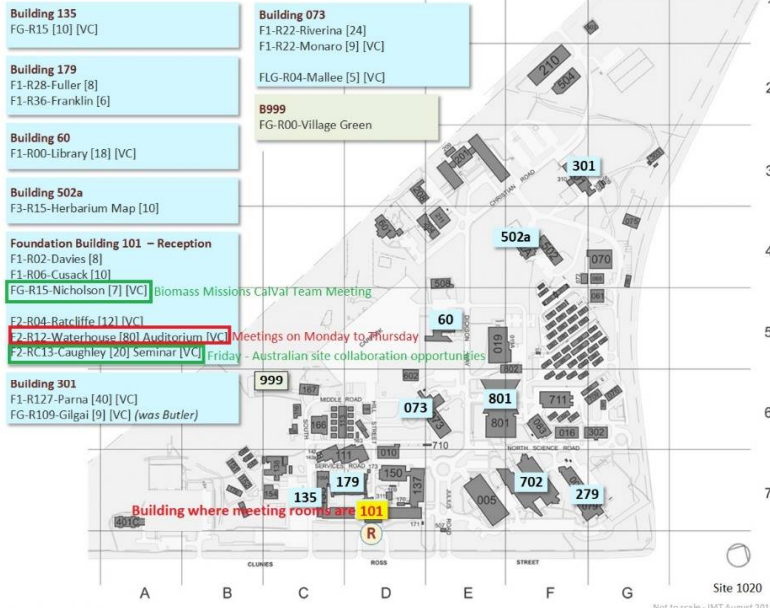

Black Mountain Science and Innovation Park – Auditoriums, Meeting, Seminar and Sprint Rooms



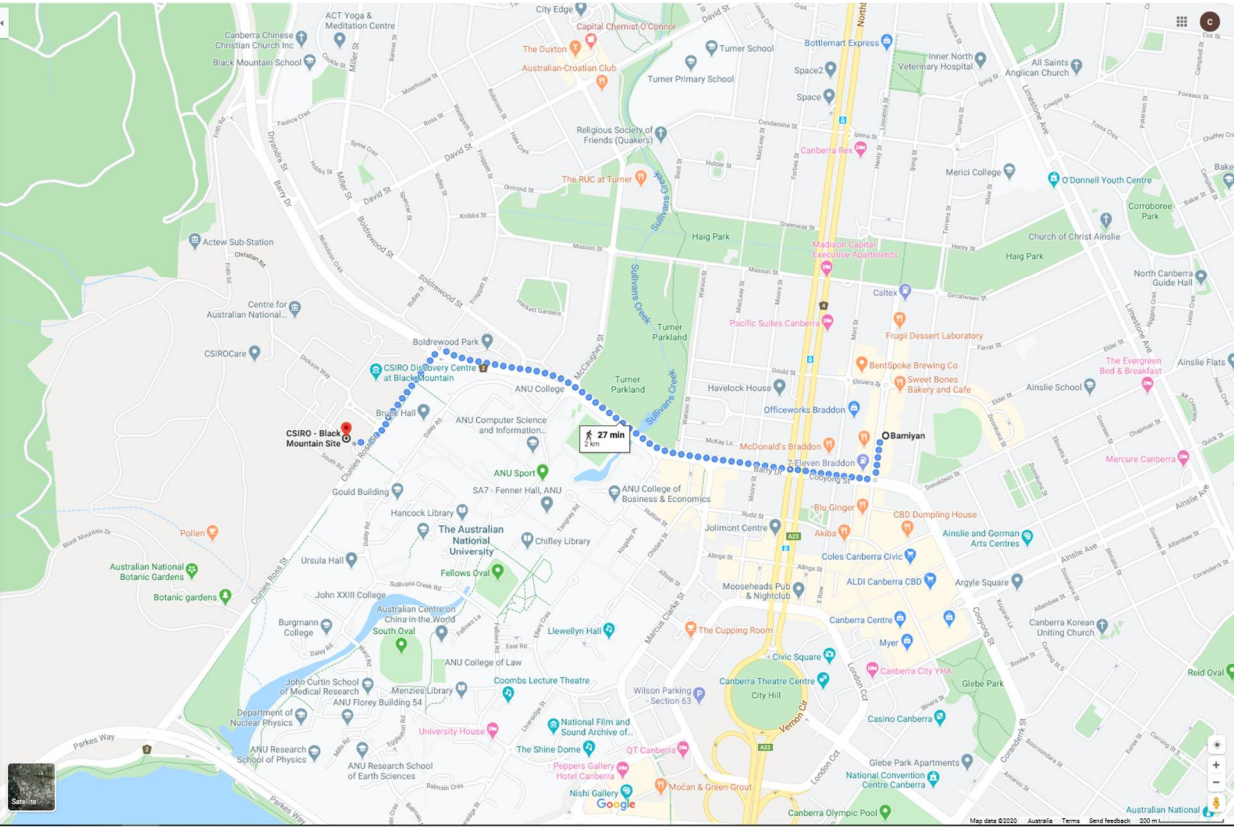

### **Language**

The official language of Australia is English.

### **Currency and means of payment**

The sole currency in Australia is the Australian dollar. Debit and Credit cards are accepted in most areas including hotels.

### **Communication**

Sim cards are widely available, and there are numerous telecommunication providers.

### **Weather**

On average, minimum and maximum daily temperatures in Canberra in March is around 11°C to 25°C.

### **Electricity**

Power points in Australia use the Type I plug (<http://www.iec.ch/worldplugs/type1.htm>). The power supply is 240V, 50HZ.

### **Time zone**

Time in Canberra is GMT + 11.
