




- The SIT Team (NOAA lead) will take over the responsibility of hosting the CEOS website. This was previously managed by JAXA and NASA. This responsibility will rotate with future SIT leadership. Support will be provided by the CEO and SEO.
- The new proposed website has been developed by the SEO (NASA) and temporarily hosted on the WGISS server. Much of the old CEOS content has been replicated and updated on the new site, along with new content for Constellations.
- The CEOS SIT team would like feedback from the CEOS users by October 18 to make a decision about using this approach at the CEOS Plenary.
- If approved, the new CEOS website would replace the old website after the CEOS Plenary Meeting in November. Until that time, the existing CEOS website (<u>www.ceos.org</u>) is still available and the "official" CEOS website.
