Summary:

A1 - October 2019: letter from the WGDis (Simona) to the Charter:

- *Confirming the collaboration between the 2 entities*
- *Clarifying the type of advance science products the WGDis can share with the Charter during an activation*
 - *Thematic activity ‘Seismic Hazards’*
 - *Thematic activity ‘Volcanoes’*
 - *Thematic activity ‘Landslides’*
 - *Other products related to activity ‘Geohazards Lab’ (multi-thematic)*
- *Calling for a simple procedure to be put in place for these exchanges*
- *Asking to the Charter to be granted the access to the Charter COS-2 information system as an” observer status” in order to check the activations status and be in a position to ask Charter data after the activation is over*
- *Defining a list of PoC in order to implement such exchanges*

A2 - March 2020: letter from the Charter to the WGDis (David) :

- *Confirming, after the last major Charter meeting, that the WGDis has been granted the so called “observer status”*
- *Defining the procedure to do so, and the privileges associated to this observer status login*
- *Proposing a simple procedure to exchange data on the opposite way (WGDis proposing data to the Charter)*
- *Inviting the WGDis to provide examples of the proposed advanced science products in order to study and analyse them as well as disclaimers associated to the products.*

B1 - July 2020: RO demonstrator asking Charter data:

The RO demonstrator sent a request to the Charter:

- Recalling the fruitful collaboration with the Charter in the course of the Haiti Recovery Observatory pilot experiment*
- Calling for a similar arrangement be set up between the Charter and the RO Demonstrator*
- Asking for an implementation of a specific dedicated way to obtain Charter data*

B2 - July 2020: Charter responding to the RO demonstrator request:

- Confirming the fruitful collaboration in the frame of the Haiti pilot,*
- Wishing to pursue the collaboration with the new demonstrator*
- Recalling the inherent short term timeframe of the Charter actions, as opposed to the long term observation windows expected by the RO demonstrator*
- Submitting the request to the Charter Executive Secretary to instruct the request for the Charter Board final decision*
