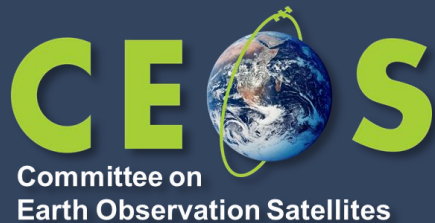

❖ **Work Plan Coordination**

- Routine interactions with all parts of CEOS to identify areas with cross-fertilisation or synergy potential

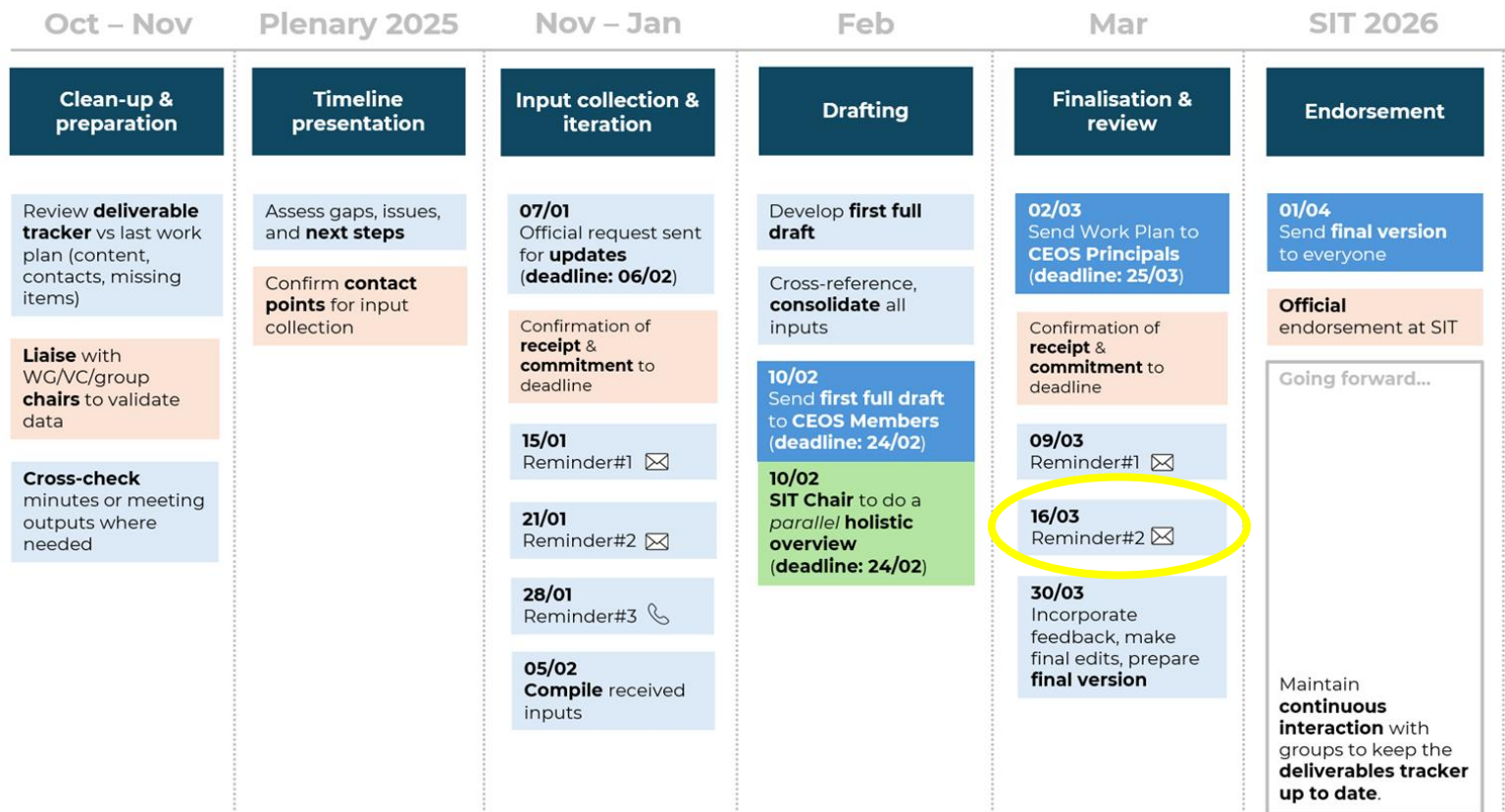
❖ **Representation and external liaison**

- GEO: PB (principal) and ExCom (alternate) representation
- Provide guidance to external stakeholders and help them prepare their application to CEOS
- Coordinate response to external requests (e.g. from UN bodies)

❖ **Maintenance:** Event tracker, mailing lists, CEOS contacts, CEOS governance documents

❖ **Ad hoc requests:** Specific actions agreed at SEC or during key events | SDG Coordination Group facilitation

❖ Current WP update cycle: under review by CEOS Principals

❖ Mid-run: Work Plan Stress-Test: checking to see if the 2026 plan is realistic, make sure the WGISS and WGDisasters work connect properly, and spot any gaps, overlap, or areas where new members might struggle to engage.

❖ GST recommendations potential incorporation:

- Activity/Action: Refine space-based observations, derived products, and delivery systems to inform disaster preparedness. *(Consider further refinement by WGDisasters before adding to the workplan.)*
- Responsible Entities: **WGDisasters** (change of scope)
- Resources Needed: Long-term
- Duration (years): 2–4
- Draft GST Roadmap Recommendations Addressed: 12. CEOS should work with WMO, CGMS, and other partners to refine space-based observations, derived products, and delivery systems to reduce vulnerability to emerging threats. Increased support for UN initiatives, such as the UN's **Early Warning for All (EW4All)**, should be explored.
