 - Reconstructing the portal based on the new architecture design (in progress) (IDN is not going to be used for the collection level search but GI-cat will be instead.)
 - 4. Future work items
 - 1. Synergy with other component of DIAS
 - 2. SSO enablement within DIAS (Water portal is a component)

3. QAs

- 1. Do you have actual users accessing the portal today? (Wyn)
 - Yes. We have over 200 views per day. (Satoko)
- 2. I forgot the password for the water portal. And it didn't seem to have a way to retrieve or reset the password. It would be helpful if the "forgot password?" link were there on the same place as the login window. (Nitant)
 - It will be updated when the new architecture is in place by the end of this Japanese fiscal year. (Yoshi)
- 3. Is a single sign on (SSO) capability in place ? (Andy)
 - Not yet. But we plan to start working on it this fiscal year to achieve SSO between the water portal and other DIAS component. (Satoko)
- 4. Does the portal support visualization capability? (Nitant)
 - Yes. Users can view browse before they download. (Yoshi)
